## How to use the ISE Interactive Curriculum Map:

### **Requirements:**

- 1. You must have Microsoft Excel installed to use this tool.
  - All UF Students, Faculty and Staff have access to Microsoft Office: Link to Install
- 2. This tool will NOT work in browser.
- 3. This tool will NOT work on an iPad.

#### STEP 1: Download and Unblock the File:

- 1. Download the Excel file to your computer.
- 2. BEFORE opening in the file, go to the location where it was downloaded, **right-click on the file name**, and select:
  - a. -> Properties
  - b. -> Under the **General** tab: Check the Box to "**Unblock**" the file.
    - i. If there is no box, this step is already completed.

# STEP 2: Save the tool to your computer.

- File type: Excel Macro-Enabled Workbook (\*.xlsm)
- You only need to perform the unblock step once on your device.

### **STEP 3: Update ActiveX Settings in Excel**

- 1. Open Excel (you may need to open it without loading the file first).
- 2. Go to: File -> Options -> Trust Center -> Trust Center Settings -> Active X Settings
- 3. Select:
  - a. "Prompt me before enabling all controls with minimal conditions."
- 4. Close and re-open the file if necessary...
